




Waterfront \$250,000




Climbing Center \$200,000

The Climbing Center will include a permanent climbing structure and indoor bouldering for year-round use by campers and group team building.

Climbing Structure / Lookout Tower \$100,000

The permanent Climbing Structure/Lookout Tower will provide year-round adventures for campers and team-building opportunities for groups.



Indoor Bouldering Wall \$50,000

The Indoor Bouldering Wall will provide safe and exciting challenges for Scouts and visitors.

The new Shooting Sports Complex will include a Gun Range, Archery Range and BB Gun Range.

Gun Range \$100,000

The Gun Range will provide a safe, exceptional experience for Scouts and visitors.

Archery Range \$50,000

The Archery Range will be fully equipped to support archery activities for ages five and up—focusing on safety, fun and skill.

BB Gun Range \$50,000

A BB Gun Range, made with our youngest visitors in mind (grades K through fifth), will provide opportunities to experience BB gun shooting and training with safety as a top priority.

Bunkhouses (5)* \$75,000

Each Bunkhouse will house up to six families to include four small rooms, two larger ADA-compliant rooms and a family area.

Large Rooms in Bunkhouse (10)* \$25,000

Each of the Camp's five new Bunkhouses will include two large ADA-compliant rooms.

Small Rooms in Bunkhouse (20)* \$20,000

Each of the Camp's five new Bunkhouses will include four small rooms.

Family Areas in Bunkhouse (5)* \$20,000


Each of the Camp's five new Bunkhouses will include one common Family Area.
